NOTICE OF CALL FOR BIDS**

The City of Walla Walla, Washington (herein called the "Owner") invites bids for the construction of the 2016 Chase Ave CDBG Sidewalk and ADA Improvements (CDBG CONTRACT NO. B-15-53-0025, PWE NO. CDBG015).

Work includes but is not limited to the removal of tripping hazards by replacing uneven and deteriorating sidewalk, the construction of new sidewalk, ADA curb ramps, and storm water infrastructure replacement.

Sealed bids plainly marked "**BID ENCLOSED – 2016 Chase Ave CDBG Sidewalk and ADA Improvements**" will be received at the office of the City Clerk, 15 North 3rd Avenue, Walla Walla, WA, 99362, until **11:00 a.m.**, local time, **Tuesday, March 15, 2016**, then publicly opened and read aloud. The Contractor is subject to all requirements related to Federal and State Prevailing Wage Rates, EEO, DBE, and Washington State Contracting Laws, and CDBG requirements, etc. The Contract time for all work shall be **Twenty Five (25) working days**.

The City of Walla Walla, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

All work performed on this project will be subject to the higher of the prevailing state or Davis Bacon federal wage rates. The City of Walla Walla is an equal opportunity and affirmative action employer. This project is funded by a federal grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Small, minority, and women owned businesses are encouraged to submit bids.

Plans and specifications will be available starting **Tuesday, February 23, 2016**. Informational copies of the plans and specifications are on file for inspection at the City of Walla Walla Engineering office, 55 E. Moore Street, and at several regional plan centers.

To become an eligible bidder on the proposed project, bidders must purchase a copy of the Contract Documents at the office of the City Engineer, 55 E. Moore Street, Walla Walla, WA, 99362, 509-527-4537. Each set is made available upon a non-refundable payment of \$40.00. Payment may be made via cash, credit card, or a check made out to City Development Services. The Contractor shall provide his/her company name, mailing address, phone number, fax number, email address, and contact name when plans are requested.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid. Only properly executed bids submitted on the form furnished by the City will be accepted. All bidders are required to submit a list of subcontractors that will perform work on the project amounting to ten percent (10%) or more of the contract amount. Award will be based on the total bid. The City Council reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids or waive any defects therein.
