- Complete your application and answer the supplemental questions.
- Attach a photocopy of driver's license or State ID Card.
- Signed acknowledgment of the CPA's "Rules of Conduct"
- Signed photo release form
- Must pass a Walla Walla Police Department background investigation. Failure to submit a complete package may result in your application not being considered.
