Frequently Used Codes**

FIELD 3	Race¹ (continued)	
5	Pacific Islander	A person with origins in any of the Pacific Islands, including the Hawaiian Islands and Samoa
6	East Indian	A person with origins in the Indian Subcontinent, including Pakistan.
7	Hispanic	A person who is Spanish-speaking.
8	Other	A person who cannot be clearly identified with any of the above groups.

Recording

Record the contact and contact statistics on the back of the Time and Activity Report (TAR). On the next available line, record the three-digit NIBRS code.

Five contact statistics are required for NIBRS 500 and nine contact statistics are required for NIBRS 600. For **NIBRS 500**, record the sex, age, and race of the offender, if a search was conducted, and if a TASER was used. For **NIBRS 600**, record the sex, age, race, search, TASER, apprehension, firearms, and juvenile disposition.

FIELD 2	Age
	Record the age of the offender.

FIELD 3	Race¹
1	White

A person with origins in Europe, North Africa, or the Middle East.

2	African American
---	------------------

A person with origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.

3	American Indian
---	-----------------

A person with origins in any of the original peoples of North America and who maintain cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition. This includes Alaskan natives.

4	Asian
---	-------

A person with origins in the Far East or Southeast Asia, including China, Japan, Korea, Cambodia, Vietnam, and the Philippines.
