

Chief,

I ran the data for the past year (October 2020 until now) on traffic stops by WSP personnel in Walla Walla County per your request. There were 7,742 total stops. Of those stops, 5,685 violators were recorded as white (approximately 73%), 1,726 violators were recorded as Hispanic (approximately 22%) and 159 violators were recorded as African American (2%). Additionally 9 were recorded as Native American, 69 were recorded as Asian, 5 were recorded as Pacific Islander, 36 were recorded as East Indian, and 49 were recorded as Other.

I have attached screen shots of the TAR manual which is the guidance on how Troopers record their contacts/traffic stop data.
